History

Sequence events, research and present information about a time past. Use a library and internet for research. Find out about the first known consumption of chocolate and first Europeans to experience it. Learn about the first mass produced chocolate bar.

Homework

Children will be set weekly spellings and asked to practice times tables (possibly using TT Rockstars). They will also be set some maths and literacy work on SeeSaw

Literacy

Sentence structure exercises, Information texts, short story writing, Recounts, Fact-files

Diary writing, Procedural writing, Narrative story writing, Report writing. In Whole Class Reading, develop vocabulary knowledge and learn to respond to different texts, answering questions which challenge children's ability to retrieve and infer information.

Geography - Locate places on a map (principal cocoa growing regions), identify principal cities, name environmental characteristics. Use 6 figure grid references to find/identify locations. Find out how volcanoes are formed and how they erupt.

PE and Games

Hockey – learning to pass, dribble and work as a team. Badminton - develop fundamental racket skills, footwork, coordination and understanding of game rules. Build confidence and fitness.
